¡Saludos de México! Praise God, I arrived safely in San Juan del Río late on October 3 and have already attended the first two weeks of classes in the School of Leadership and Ministry Development (SLMD). Thank you **so** much for your thoughts and prayers during this major transition. God allowed the move to go smoothly and I already feel quite settled into life here in Mexico. I am living with two guys from San Juan del Rio which is allowing me to learn a lot about the city, the country, the language and the culture. Additionally, 6 of the 9 students in the SLMD are more comfortable in Spanish than English, so while the classes are translated, Spanish is the go-to language in all of our informal times together.

The first 2 weeks of classes have gone very well. We learned about qualities of great leaders in the first week, and in the second we studied how Jesus applied these in His life. This week we will learn about conflict resolution. We are also planning various outreach ministries to share the good news of the gospel with our neighbours.

# THE SENT


from silent to sent
