On May 10, 8 students and 2 staff (including me) left San Juan del Rio with a mission: make God known. My primary prayer request throughout the entire outreach was that God would provide "open doors to share the gospel", and WOW did He provide! Over the course of our 7-week outreach, we estimate that our team visited between 200-300 houses to share the gospel, pray for the sick, and share messages of encouragement from God's word. We also ran dozens of children's programs, church gatherings, evangelism workshops, and taught about the importance of missions. We saw dozens of people make commitments to follow Jesus!

One of my favourite moments was sitting with a group of four youth during one of the children's programs. Luke (one of the students) and I shared the gospel with those four young men, and afterwards asked if any of them wanted to commit their lives to Christ. None of them responded, but afterwards one of the guys came up to me and told me he wanted to accept Christ, but he wanted to pray privately because "it was a personal, intimate decision I need to make with God".

Now, as one of the leaders of the team, a large part of my focus was on discipling the DTS students who then evangelize and disciple others. My role also involved driving, translating, meeting and organizing ministry opportunities with our contacts, budgeting, photographing, and ensuring the individual and overall wellbeing of our team. I put into practice many things I learned in the School of Leadership last fall.
