I started going in August (check out my past newsletters on my website if you'd like to read more!) and we ran the Alpha: Youth discussion videos. Over these 6 months we have studied the Bible, discussed Christianity and topics such as the Gospel, who God is, fear, prayer, reading the Bible, having healthy friendships and relationships, why God does things that we don't understand, and most recently: the differences between traditional Mexican Catholicism and Christianity. We talked a little bit about baptism, communion, and sabbath (why it's good to have a healthy rhythm of rest!)
