#### 52 IN 520 (REHAB MINISTRY)



Interactive map of all known rehab centres in San Juan del Río (click to explore) We have been making progress on the 52 in 520 initiative! We had a meeting with all base staff to brainstorm and pray about next steps, and how different people would be involved. We are organizing a team of intercessors who will pray every single day for this initiative, as well as designating point people that will help facilitate church trainings, rehab connections, and other key roles. We have also created a map of all known rehab centres in the city, colour coding them in order to see progress! <u>Click on the map picture to explore it!</u>

One of the main goals of 52in520 churches is to get involved in reaching our city. In 2024 one of our goals is to run 3 workshops with 3 training churches, which we hope will result in at least 6 new rehabs being reached (at least 2 small groups from each church). Please pray that these trainings will be effective and useful!

Last month we ran a Rehab Directors dinner to strengthen our relationships with them, and share the gospel directly with them, in hopes that through interactions like these, and weekly connection, many will come to know the Lord and base

#### JOURNEY TO BETHLEHEM



We invited missionaries and local churches to be involved in the cast and crew, and had over **140** volunteers assist in evangelizing over **500** people from the community throughout the event!! It was a lot of hard work, but we know that God was working throughout the whole thing, in the design and preparation, the acting, the connections, and the final cleanup.






