52 IN 520 (REHAB MINISTRY)




Wow, praise God!! With the recent developments, around 280 people weekly bible studies. in hearing about Jesus and being discipled!! 73.1% of the rehab centres still have no regular contact with a Christian, so our job is not finished! But we rejoice & celebrate the progress that is being made, and the people who are coming to know the Lord as a result!! Please continue to pray for wisdom in how to faithfully complete this mission, and that God would cause it to be fruitful! We have seen first hand the incredible transformative work God does through this ministry, and we pray that more people will experience the power of God's redemptive work through Jesus!

Updates on rehab ministry:

- Casa de Lois, a previously un-engaged rehab, now has a weekly bible study led by a YWAM missionary and various women from a local church!
- Nuevo Ser, a rehab we have visited in the past, now has a weekly bible study led by a YWAM missionary and supported by various people from a local church! 16 people accepted Christ there, and are looking to be baptized soon!
- Flor de Vida, a women's rehab with ~30 women now has a weekly bible study run by YWAM missionaries (Bonnie goes to this one regulary!)

Please pray for these new engagements, specifically that God would reveal Himself to the women in these centres!

HIGH SCHOOL TEAM



Every year in March we receive a team from a high school in the USA that come prepared to share the gospel through dramas, puppet shows, and science experiments. It is such a joy to partner with these young people and facilitate their ministry times! This year, 24 high students ministered school in children's home. a couple schools. various rehab centres, in the villages in the mountains nearby, and in the streets of our neighbourhood.

One of the unique ministries that the team was able to do was basic health screening in rehabs. Some of the high school students are interested in studying medicine, so they teamed up with our nurses on base to check blood sugar and blood pressure levels, as well as give basic vision tests.





As a result of these pre-screening health clinics, 143 people were screened, 75 people received reading glasses to help their vision (and help them to read the bible!), and 15-20 people with high blood pressure/high blood glucose were alerted to follow up and seek medical care for possible diabetes or hypertension. The team also presented the gospel through a drama. We love sharing the gospel along with practical demonstrations of love and care!











PORTO VELHO (NEW PROPERTY)

God has provided a new property for our base! The property that you can see in the picture on the right is on a street called Porto Velho (Portuguese for "Old Port"), which is what we plan to nickname the buildings.

Our plan is to turn it into a multi-use site with a classroom, dorm-style housing, office space, and a cafe that can be



used to engage and connect with the local community. Obviously it needs a LOT of work to become a functional space, and we have various ways that you could get involved! If you have skills (e.g. woodworking, painting, tiling, etc.) or if you are interested in donating generally or giving a specific item for the project (e.g. bunk beds, mattresses, pillows, shelving, tables, chairs, kitchen items, white boards, etc), please let us know! Also, we would love your prayer support for this project. Since the purchase, we have had some upsetting setbacks, including vandals that started a fire inside one of the buildings and spray painted the outside of the buildings. But we believe it will be a place that many Mexican Missionaries will be commissioned from!

At the beginning of March we spent a morning doing some cleanup and tidying of the property. Because it has been sitting vacant for 15 years, there is a lot of dust, garbage, and vandalism that has made the property look quite terrible. But we are beginning to change that and are excited to see this place transformed from a garbage dump into a place where missionaries will be trained up, equipped and sent out to tell the nations about Jesus!
